

BREADSALL NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN
Update & Questionnaire

Dear Resident,

We need your views.

We are now making good progress with the Neighbourhood Plan and we attach the initial draft for you to read and comment upon. This is an important document which will have a statutory function in influencing planning decisions throughout the parish and will affect all residents by helping to shape the way the parish evolves in the future. The Neighbourhood Plan is being promoted by the Parish Council which has appointed an Advisory Group to handle the process. The Advisory Group has compiled the enclosed consultation draft based on the feedback from the initial questionnaire issued in December 2016 and the public meeting held in March 2017. To keep the document to a manageable size we have used smaller print and omitted the appendices but copies of the full document with larger scale print are available at the village shop. There is also a complete copy on the Parish Council website.

Before seeking formal approval for the Neighbourhood Plan we need to repeat the consultation process to check the whole community's response to the consultation draft and to make any necessary adjustments. The Borough and County Councils will be consulted at the same time. The Plan will then be scrutinised by an Examiner appointed by the Borough Council. The final stage in the adoption will be a referendum of all parish residents. We hope that this can all be completed during 2018.

Come along to the public meeting in the memorial hall at 7pm on 23 February 2018 for the presentation, free refreshments and fun!

Would you now please read the consultation draft and then complete and return the attached questionnaire no later than 26 January 2018? Additional paper copies of the questionnaire can be obtained from the village shop or by downloading the PDF version on the Parish Council website. There is also a copy on the Parish Council website which can be completed online. The questionnaire includes instructions on how to return it.

A further public meeting will be held in the memorial hall on Friday 23 February 2018 at 7pm with a presentation describing the current position with the Neighbourhood Plan including the outcome of the present consultation exercise. As at the previous public meeting there will be free food and drink, a quiz and opportunities to discuss any element of the Neighbourhood Plan. The last public meeting was extremely successful with attendance well in excess of 100 and we hope to repeat this success. Please put this date in your diaries and take the opportunity to get involved in the Neighbourhood Plan.

The Neighbourhood Plan will affect all residents in the parish and is now at a critical stage. Please make your contribution by completing the questionnaire and attending the public meeting on 23 February.
